The very discovery of a wrecks is an "adverse impact" on the wreck because these discoveries can never be kept confidential due to the large number of contractors and personnel involved. Unscrupulous salvors will be led to these wreck sites and the archaeological and historical information will be lost.

The consenting process must ensure that the owner of the seabed and the developer are required to provide full financial resources for the investigation, survey, identification, protection and long term management of these archaeological sites so that the information derived from them is made available the current and future generations.
